Student Numbers

In response to demand, we will expand our Form 1 Girls intake from 27 to 40 students in 2025. The College currently hosts 503 students, and we anticipate welcoming 559 students by January 2025.

Campus Developments

- Astro Turf: Thanks to the generous funding from Falconian Simon Rudland and the Rudland family, this project is progressing smoothly, with completion anticipated in early 2025. We are also grateful to Andre Zietsman and his company, Bitumen World, for their professional approach in constructing the Astro, especially given the current economic climate.
- Solar Farm: Our 1MW solar project is well underway, and we expect it to be operational by March 2025, reducing our reliance on traditional energy sources.
- Staff Village: Site clearing has begun, and construction is scheduled to start soon. This project aims to enhance living conditions for our dedicated staff, with special thanks to the Falconian community for their generous contributions.
- Kestrel House Expansion: The expansion of our Form 1 dormitory remains on track for completion by the end of this year.
- Classroom Construction: We plan to begin building two additional classrooms to support our growing student body. Completion is expected by January 2025.

In 2025, we are introducing a Sixth Form Diploma Program, fully launching in 2026, to support students with diverse career goals. Led by Mr Andy McKechnie, this program will equip students with practical skills in areas like agriculture, welding, plumbing, mechanics, first aid, heavy
